Treasurer's Report

Every year you are solicited for a donation from both the local chapter, Alpha Upsilon, and the national office. The Alpha Upsilon chapter does not directly benefit from any donations sent to Alpha Upsilon, to my attention, help to pay for the publications you receive and the balance is used for general fraternity upkeep.

The amounts listed below are the funds that the fraternity utilized for house maintenance after publication costs had been deducted.

1985	\$ 696.00
1986	\$1040.00
1987	\$1801.00
1988	\$1045.00
1989	\$ 938.00

In the past five years we have completed the following list of repairs:

New roof	\$35,000.00
New kitchen & bathroom floors	\$10,000.00
Exterior masonry work	\$ 4,000.00
New garage heater	\$ 2,000.00

As you can see, the maintenance to the house is very costly. The balance of the money used for repairs is generated from the undergraduates' rent and investment income. Even with these other sources of income we've previously found it necessary to borrow from the university.
